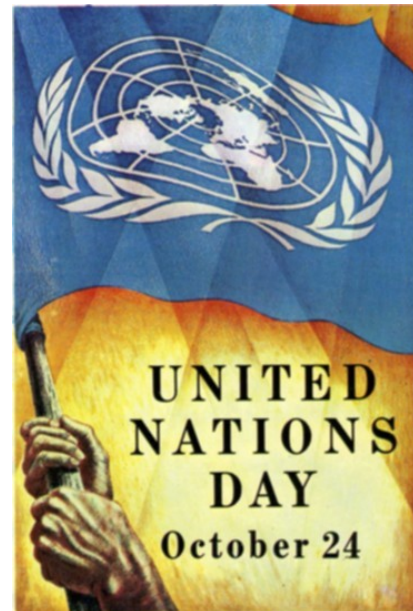

Preserve your Pumpkin

The HixNewsletter is always posted online at our homepage: <http://hixnews.com>

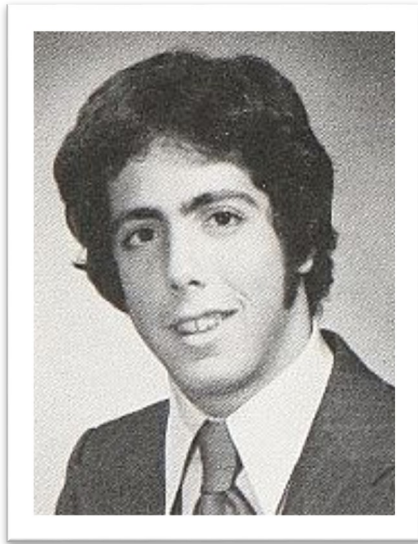
When our homepage opens, click]"The Newsletter]" link in the upper left of the orange header to get to the current issue of the Newsletter.

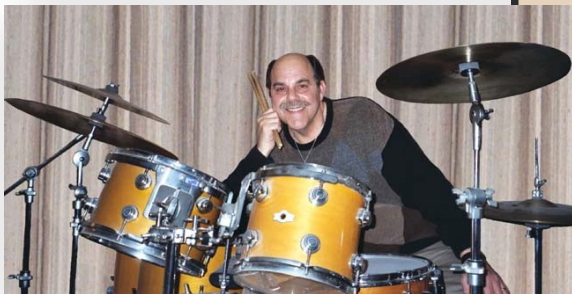

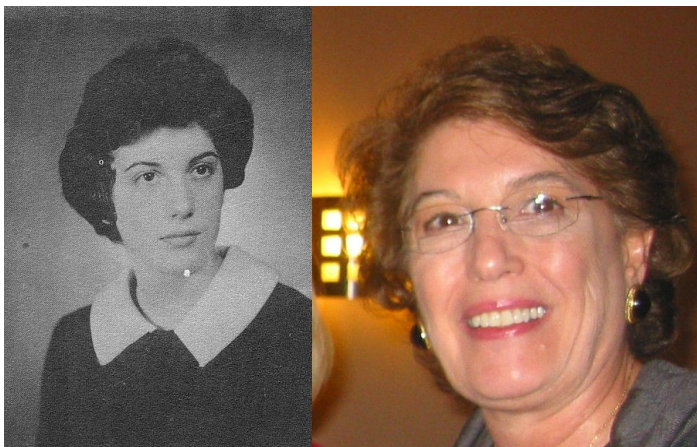

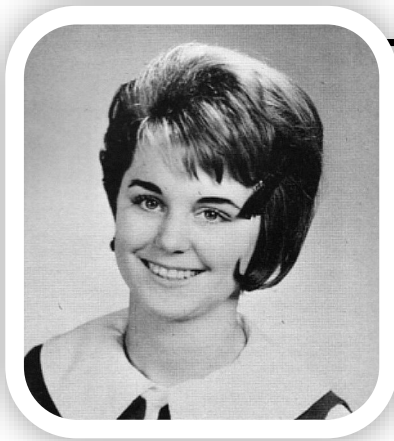
Producers at the studio say his entry was unlike the others. It came in an envelope with the lyrics written in a letter.

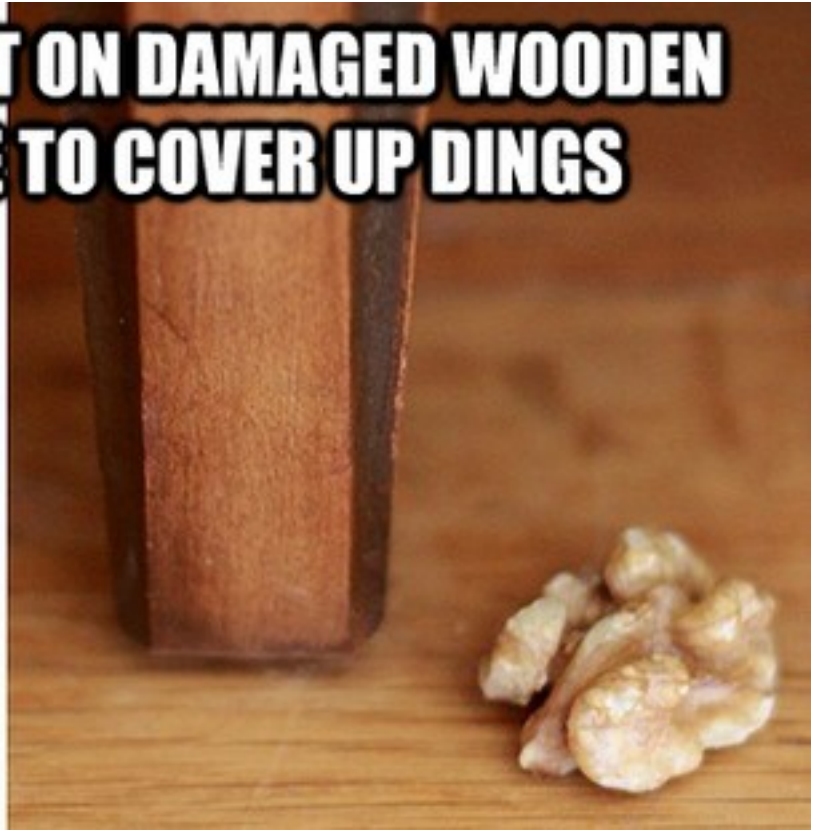

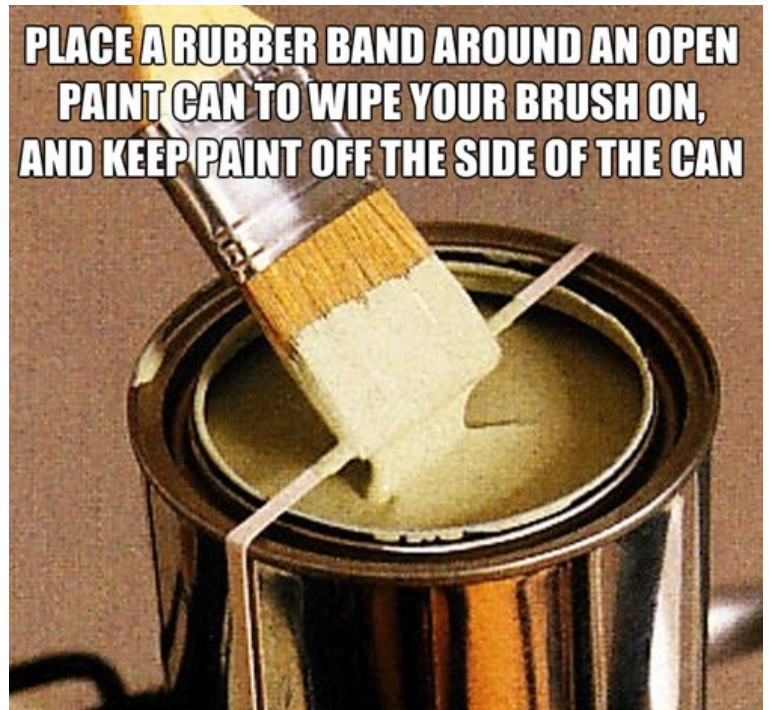
